The Center for Fine Art Photography presents a photographic exhibit called **Abstractions**. The next exhibit of 2007 opens on March 30th and runs through



The theme for *Abstractions* is photographic art that depicts real forms in a simplified or reduced way, keeping only an allusion of the original natural subject
